#### **City of Fullerton Statement on Police Personnel Actions**

FULLERTON, Calif. (August 28, 2018) — On Saturday, August 25, 2018, Fullerton City Manager Ken Domer named Captain Bob Dunn as Acting Chief of Police, and placed Fullerton Chief of Police David Hendricks and Captain Thomas Oliveras, Operations Division Commander, on paid administrative leave, pending the outcome of an ongoing investigation.

This decision followed notification by the Irvine Police Department to Fullerton's City Manager of an investigation into an incident that occurred on Friday, August 24, 2018 at a concert venue in the City of Irvine. This investigation is unconnected to the performance of official duties, as it relates entirely to allegations of off-duty conduct.

As part of its commitment to ensuring the highest level of professionalism in serving our community, the City is hiring an external investigator to conduct an administrative review. The City will not provide further information at this time, out of respect for the integrity of the ongoing investigations.

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
